





## **Crough Wood Walk to Mahon Falls**

In conjunction with the **Tús** Community Work Placement Initiative, Waterford Leader Partnership Ltd is delighted to be involved with **Comeragh Community Development Group**, in providing beneficial assistance to the local community, while also boosting the work readiness of its Tús Participants.

The Comeragh Community Development Group is the developer of the Crough Wood Extension Walk, near Mahon Bridge.

Crough Wood is situated in a scenic and tranquil location, just past Mahon Bridge, on the road to the Mahon Falls.

Situated underneath the majestic Comeraghs, and with the River Mahon meandering alongside, the walkway is the perfect location in which to relax and unwind, and has proved immensely popular with both locals and visitors alike.

Popular with hill walking clubs, the area also attracts many artists and photographers, entranced by the area's natural beauty and abundant wildlife.

The walk was officially opened in 2007 and maintenance work is carried out by volunteers from the local community, now being aided greatly by two Tús Participants. The Comeragh Community Development Group have since been engaged in efforts to extend the existing walkway and Phase 2 of the walkway is now open, and stretches as far as the cattle grid, near the famous Magic Road. Phase 3 is currently under construction and will progress along the side of the river and up towards the Mahon Falls.

The walkway further opens up the Comeraghs, making an area of natural beauty more easily accessible and providing an important local recreational facility.
