





South East Enterprise Support Initiative during COVID-19

WIT is offering four accredited short courses fully online and at no cost to the student over summer 2020 as part of the college's response to the Covid emergency.

Digital Marketing and Social Media (6 week on-line module - 10 credits at level 6)

This course provides learners with the detailed and practical knowledge required to develop digital marketing and social media expertise including Digital Marketing Planning, Strategy and Tools; Social Media Strategy, Planning and Tools; Digital Marketing Analytics. This course may assist companies seeking new modes of promotion using virtual tools.

Payroli and Computerised Accounts (5 week on-line module - 10 credits at level 6)

This course facuses on migrating existing payroll systems to an on-line environment. The Payroll aspect of the course will cover Setting up Payroll, Processing Payroll and Report generating. The Financial Accounting aspect of the course will cover Purchase Ledger, Sales Ledger, Nominal Ledger, Banking, VAT and Reporting. This course may assist companies seeking to migrate existing paper-based systems to payroll services on-line.

Certificate in Management of Work-Related Stress (12 week on-line Certificate - 29 credits at level 6)

The course consists of two ten credit modules. It will also give participants an introduction to the parameters of modern governance of social enterprises in order to meet the expectations of major stakeholders. It may be of assistance to any social enterprise currently managing funding and other financial challenges during this period.






