Due to a staff member returning to full time education, we have a role of Guesthouse assistant available immediately.

This is a varied role that involves helping in all aspects of the business, from preparing breakfast to dealing with guest queries to cleaning to updating social media. We would like someone with common sense who can work on their own initiative, who is friendly and enjoys engaging with people and who is energetic.

The business is a mix of a guesthouse and a backpacker hostel (although the backpacker hostel will remain closed until the end of the year, so for now we are just a guesthouse).

The job consists of 4 shifts a week - 4 mornings from 7.30 to 2pm one week and 4 evenings from 3pm to 9.30pm the following week. While this can give balance to some people's schedules, it won't suit some candidates. If there are particular days you can't work that's fine as long as we can know and schedule in advance.

The morning shifts involves opening reception and setting up the breakfast service, doing up a cleaning schedule for the cleaning staff and checking their work (there is also some cleaning involved with the role, particularly in training new staff. The afternoon shift is mainly concerned with processing guests checking in and finishing laundry. 


