## Comeragh Council extends votes of sympathy

THE elected members of Comeragh Municipal District Council extended a vote of sympathy on the recent death of well known publican in Kilmacthomas, Pat (Mosh) Morrissey, of the Square, Kilmacthomas.

Cllr. John O'Leary proposed the vote of sympathy to the Morrissey family on the death of Pat, which sad event occurred on 30th September, last.

Carhaonleach Cllr. Liam Brazil seconded the vote of sympathy.

"Pat was a local publican in Kilmac" who lost his battle to cancer," Cllr. Brazil said.

"He was a great footballer in his days. He played for the John Mitchels, one of the great clubs of the '70s. Pat played corner forward in 1970, 1973 and 1976. In the 1973 final he scored a goal and a point against Athlone at Dungarvan's Friar field, and scored a goal and a point against Dunhill in 1976 in Walsh Park," Cllr. Brazil said.

Cllr. Brazil expressed sympathies to Pat's wife, Crena, their sons Paddy and Michael and daughter Frieda and extended family.

**OTHER VOTES OF SYMPATHY**

Cllr. O'Leary extended a vote

of sympathy to the family of the late Sean Murphy, of Mahon Bridge.

"Sean was a great historian and everyone knew him from his time making films with the Bachelors in Trouble," Cllr. O'Leary said.

Concurring with the sentiments, Cllr. Brazil said: "Everybody knew Sean as 'Jack' in the Bachelors in Trouble".

"Sean also worked in this building [Dungarvan Civic Offices] for a good few years as the community officer.

"Sean was a great historian. He came from Kilmac" but perched his life under the Comeragh Mountains in Mahon Bridge," Cllr. Brazil added.

Meanwhile, Cllr. Brazil also extended a vote of sympathy to Waterford Council's Karen Cheevers, whose mother passed away recently.

Proposing the vote of sympathy, Cllr. Brazil said Ms. Cheevers' mother, Eileen Cheevers (née McDonnell) of Bishopsgrove, Ferrybank, Waterford, sadly passed away on 15th October, last.

He extended his deepest sympathies to Karen Cheevers, who heads up the communications office at the local authority.

## Engineer commits to examining road before re-lining

THE District Engineer of the Comeragh area is to examine whether a road near Kilmacthomas needs strengthening works before it is re-lined.

Carhaonleach Cllr. Liam Brazil told the October meeting of Comeragh Municipal District Council asked if there was "any hope of getting the road between the Five Cross Roads and Griffin's Garage re-lined?"

He described the road (L3209) as "very dangerous". "It's up on a hill and you haven't much to play with on

both sides of the road. A white line in the middle of the road would be a great help to road users," Cllr. Brazil said.

District Engineer Maria Goff gave a commitment to examine the road.

"I don't know if it was already lined previously," she said.

"It might be the case that the road needs strengthened as well and we won't line it if it needs to be strengthened. We'll put that in the programme for strengthening first [before it's re-lined], but I'll have a look at it first," Ms. Goff added.

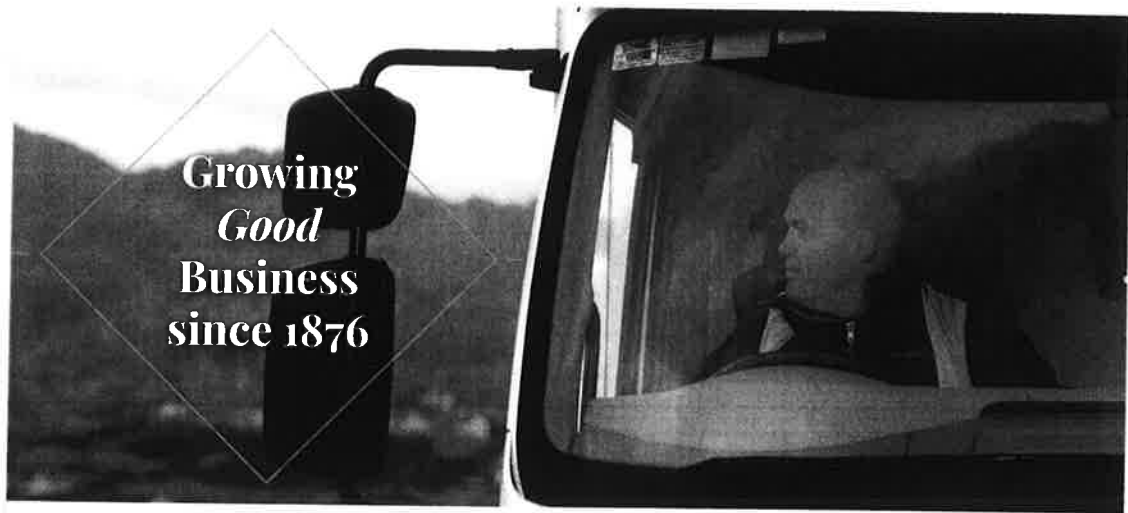

## Background to the Programme

Waterford Wexford Training Services, part of WWETB, launched the Professional HGV Driving Programme in Wexford Town. The programme was developed in conjunction with the IRHA with the purpose of increasing standards within the Industry.

The programme is funded under the SOLAS Traineeship scheme (Shaping skills, building careers) and is accredited by City and Guilds. The Accredited element of the programme is based around the competencies demonstrated by the learners during the 8-week work experience built into this course; this includes assessed competencies for areas such as route planning, food safety, health & safety and customer service.

## Course Description
