# Five ways to get ahead in your career

Getting a foothold in your dream career can seem impossible if you haven't grown up with the 'right' connections and strong levels of support – financial or otherwise.

Jobs expert at Totajobs Stephen Warnham says: "The adage of: 'It's not what you know, it's who you know,' continues to sadly ring true for many – as only a third of people from lower socioeconomic groups have received help from family or friends in securing a job."

He explains: "A person's socioeconomic background has a tremendous impact on the opportunities they have in their lifetime – whether it's their access to education, employment, or their salary potential."

Employers can do their bit, through targeted work experience programmes, financial support, or support in building a career network, he says.

These are Warnham's tips for helping job candidates remove obstacles, and boost their ability to move into their chosen career...



## 1. APPLY FOR JOBS VALUING TRANSFERABLE SKILLS OVER 'SET' QUALIFICATIONS

"Increasingly, we're seeing employers looking for transferable skills over set qualifications, and we're encouraging more businesses to do the same, in the hope that a broader range of jobs will become accessible for people of all educational backgrounds," Warnham says.

"When looking for a job,

remember no one is a perfect candidate; if you don't meet all the requirements of a role, apply anyway and focus on the value of your transferable skills, such as organisation or communication, in your application."

## 2. LEARN WHILE YOU EARN

"Training is often available as part of the onboarding process in a new job, to equip you with the essential skills you need," says Warnham.

progression routes, to make this a key step in reducing employment inequalities."

## 3. KNOW YOUR WORTH IN THE JOBS MARKET

Warnham says: "It can be tempting to fall into a trap of believing that if you have no prior experience, you're not entitled to receive pay for your work – as the opportunity in doing you a favour."

## 4. CONSIDER HOW REMOTE OR FLEXIBLE WORKING COULD WORK FOR YOU

Many workers will never return to the office full-time, as the coronavirus pandemic has accelerated flexible and home working trends.

"Depending on your situation or preference, it can benefit you in several ways," Warnham explains.

"Remote working can help you save money and potentially provide better access to secure work in the future, as this type of work can help bring a broader range of job opportunities to different areas in the UK.

"While technical

equipment like a laptop is typically provided so you can perform your role, some employers are also actively supporting people during the application process, such as by providing tablets for video interviews, or providing the ability to hotspot if local internet connection isn't reliable."

## 5. CREATE YOUR OWN NETWORK

Social media has opened up huge opportunities to make professional connections with people you might not otherwise have met.

Warnham says: "While it may take time, building your own network from the ground up can have real value in the long run, especially if you're at the early stages of your career."

"Connect with industry professionals on professional social media platforms, making it clear why you want to connect with them and building rapport."

"Using online platforms to reach out to those already in the industry for advice is a great way of showcasing your proactiveness."

**BEFORE A MEETING**

First step is to set up a ith your direct line ven if they're not

the person who ultimately holds the purse strings.

"Going above them will play out badly politically in the vast majority of cases," says Ellie Green, jobs expert at Totaljobs.

However, the way you approach the issue of pay can vary depending on your relationship with your boss:

"Raising the subject informally may prove to be more successful for some and can be the start of you building a case with more senior stakeholders, but other managers will prefer a formal approach."

## DO KNOW YOUR WORTH

Before the meeting, research typical salary levels for your role, both within your company and externally.

"This way, you can argue that your current pay is not in line with the market and make it clear that this is important to you," says Green, who suggests using the Totaljobs Salary Checker.

## DON'T MAKE DEMANDS

Even if you feel you're being treated unfairly, playing hardball can sometimes backfire, especially if you're boss isn't in a position to alter salaries at the moment.

Instead of demanding that you must have a pay rise immediately, you might want to consider going into the conversation with questions and an open attitude.

"Ask the question more along the lines of, 'Is there budget available for pay rises?', or, 'What is happening with bonuses?'" says Dr Audrey Tang, psychologist and author of *Be A Great Manager - Now!*

## DO SHOW EVIDENCE

"Remember that while it's important to be ambitious, your expectations should be realistic," says Green.

"Any decision they make will be a balance between their bottom line and the value you bring, so make sure you come with a comprehensive overview of what you've achieved over the



last year, and what you expect to bring in the months or years to come."

Examples of evidence might be improved results or revenue, personally or for your team, additional projects you've taken on, or positive feedback from clients. Green adds: "Always remember to tie this back to business results."

## DO FOLLOW UP IN WRITING

After the meeting, follow

up with a polite email thanking your boss for their time and summarising the key talking points, so there's "a clear paper trail of your requests and your achievements are well documented," says Green.

Dr Tang says this is 'a normal practice that people don't always do'.

## DON'T GIVE UP HOPE

"If things don't go your way and the request for a rise is

denied, don't be disheartened," says Green. You can use the feedback to find out what you need to do in order to reach your salary goals.

"Ask your boss what you need to do in the next period where you want to go, and what you will provide in the pathway going forward. Ensure that next time you ask the question, you have exactly what you need to succeed."
