JobsPlus Employer Incentive Scheme

JobsPlus Employer Incentive Scheme, from the Department of Social Protection, encourages and rewards employers who offer employment opportunities to the long term unemployed.

How Does the JobsPlus Employer Incentive Scheme Work:

The Scheme offers grants, which are payable monthly in arrears via Electronic Funds Transfer over a two-year period. The person employed under the Scheme must remain in employment with the same employer (who is taking part in the Scheme) during this time period.

The incentive is targeted at the more long term unemployed and is set at two levels:

- > recruits unemployed for more than 12 months but less than 24 months: €7,500
- > recruits unemployed for more than 24 months: €10,000

Main Eligibility Criteria:

- > Jobs must be full-time employments of over 30 hours per week, spanning at least four days per week
- > Employers must be compliant with Irish Tax and Employment Laws
- Eligible jobs must not displace any other employee

How To Apply for the JobsPlus Employer Incentives Scheme:

<u>Employers register on here</u> to become an eligible employer under the Scheme (employers will also be able to instruct potential employees to apply online to verify their status as an eligible employee under the Scheme).

If an employer decides to recruit an additional employee, they can complete the <u>JobsPlus Online Application for Employers</u> giving, for example, the name of company, size of workforce, bank details and economic sector of company. Once this is submitted an officer of the department will review and check the tax clearance certificate is in order and email the employer if it is approved.


Once eligibility is confirmed by the department, an employer may start to recruit. They could contact their local Intreo Centre to discuss their vacancy. They may also advertise the vacancy on www.jobsireland.ie.

Work Placement Experience Programme

The Work Placement Experience Programme (WPEP) is a 6-month, 30 hour per week voluntary work experience programme. The programme is for Jobseekers that are currently in receipt of a qualifying social welfare payment and who have been unemployed for six months (156 days) or more, (see qualifying list here).

If you would like to re-train and gain experience in another type of employment, this programme can help you build new skills and gain work experience. You cannot take a placement where you already have built up experience in the role.

You can work part-time while you are on the programme providing the part-time work does not impact your placement. The part-time work cannot be with the WPEP Host.





Tús - Community Work Placement Initiative

This is a community work placement scheme providing **short-term working** opportunities for unemployed people. The jobs are to benefit the community and are provided by community and voluntary organisations in both urban and rural areas.

To qualify for Tús, you must:

- have been continuously unemployed for at least 12 months and "signing on" on a full-time basis,
- have been receiving either Jobseeker's Benefit or Jobseeker's Allowance for at least 12 months,
- be currently receiving Jobseeker's Allowance.

If you are unemployed and eligible for the scheme, your local local Intreo centre or Social Welfare Branch Office will identify and contact you.

Community Employment Scheme

The Community Employment (CE) programme is designed to help people who are long-term unemployed (or suffer a particular disadvantage) to get back to work by offering part-time, temporary placements in jobs based within the local community. Participation on CE is for 19.5 hours per week.

The training provided through CE is delivered within a Quality Assurance framework. See details of recognised courses on www.qqi.ie that can be achieved and that lead to major awards on the National Framework of Qualifications.

CE placements are for one year, however if you are working towards a major QQI Award you may be eligible for up to an additional 2 years on CE (maximum total of 3 consecutive years).






